- (5) Gave on the first day of the week. (1Cor.16:1-2.)

If a religious group doesn't do these things in worship or adds human traditions not authorized by God, then you know that group is in error and worshiping improperly. We should take it seriously because Jesus condemned beliefs and actions that are contrary to His standard. (Please read Mt.15:1-14; Gal.1:8-9; 2Thess.2:10-12.)

I saw someone bored and sleepy during the worship. He prefers dancing, clapping, jumping and all mechanical instruments should be accompanied in singing and even in praying. One time he said, he prefers singing only and not listen to the word of God. All instructions seem to be useless and only his desire should be followed.

The question is, why do we need to change God's command? If we claim to be an obedient child of God, why not sincerely follow His command? Are the New Testament instructions given not enough? If we are looking outside of what is instructed to us, then we are not following God's command. Matthew 15:8-9 says, "These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men."

I would like to encourage you to stay close to Jesus and follow His commandments. Since we claim that we are true followers of Christ, let us sincerely follow his word, so our hopes and dreams to be with God in heaven, will not be in vain.
