CAN YOU BE PROUD WHEN YOU DIE? By David Cariaga

Since 1987 I have been preaching, and there are some questions that are very hard for me to answer. Often they are very personal and highly specific. There are questions, from brethren, about their close friends or love ones that I hesitate to answer, out of fear of hurting their feelings. Like what happened one time, a brother came to me to tell me; "My brother Johnny once professed to be a Christian. He once prayed to accept Jesus Christ as his Savior from sin. But he never was a committed Christian. He never had time to read the Bible. Didn't pray much, miss church sometimes and give sometimes Sunday contributions. He still swore sometimes and could be no different from his unchristian friends. He pretty much lived for himself. So, tell me brother David, if my brother Johnny dies will he go to heaven or to hell?"

It's not an easy question so it can't have an easy answer. I explained that I really don't know another person's eternal destiny. That's up to God and I'm not God. But then I said: "I really don't know about your friend Johnny but I can tell you it's just not possible for a person to accept Jesus Christ and become a Christian without being changed. Yes, Jesus always changes people and people have to sincerely change their lives to accept Jesus. What I suggest is that you leave your friend Johnny to God. God is always fair and just and always does what is right. But, what about you? Who do you say that Jesus is and what difference is he making in your life?"

Listen to what Jesus said in Luke 9:23-26. And he said to them all, "If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life for my sake, the same shall save it. For what is a man advantaged, if he gains the whole world, and lose himself, or be cast away? For whosoever shall be ashamed of me and of my words, of him shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he shall come in his own glory, and in his Father's, and of the holy angels."

I encourage everyone reading to look at yourself carefully. Give your full commitment to our Lord. Live a life pleasing to Him and one day, when we die (like Johnny), it will not be decided by any preacher but we - ourselves can proudly say with confidence "I am going to be with my God in Heaven."
