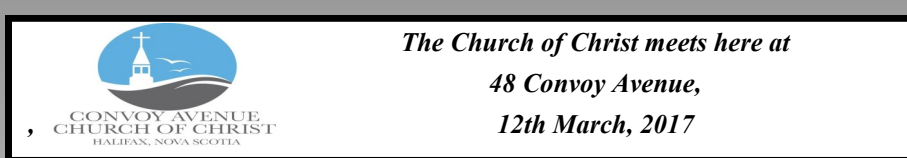

"What is happening to the Human Race?"

I had the opportunity to counsel with my students on their "life plans." As an educator for almost thirty years, my mission is to lead young people in the right path to have a right life – physically and spiritually. I am relating this experience because our world seems to forget where we are leading our youth. We have a country against crime. Our civil society is against killing innocent individuals – especially those that are defenseless and innocent. This principle has been maintained for so long and we fight for what is right – to give justice to those who are victims of crimes. Our society pushes this advocacy for life preservation and protection of innocent individuals.

What happens now? We are in a country who advocates peace, justice and equality. However, details from Life Site News that "Prime Minister Justin Trudeau announced today that Canada will spend \$650 million in the next three years to increase access to abortion in developing countries." Why be an advocate of Abortion? What is abortion? An **abortion** is known as a 'termination' or 'termination of pregnancy'. Other suggests that abortion is the killing of life to stop pregnancy.

The killing of a defenseless innocent child is something we horribly imagine. Johanne Brownrigg, public affairs director for Campaign Life Coalition said *"We are horrified by our government's decision to spend more than half a billion dollars on spreading abortion across the world."* Matthew Wojciechowski, spokesperson for Campaign Life Coalition said; *"Our nation, under Trudeau, has now become one of the world's top exporters of abortion and sterilization. I guess Trudeau's admiration for China's dictatorship and horrific family planning programs are now shaping Canada's foreign policy."*

The Bible strongly condemns the shedding of innocent life. The Bible clearly prohibits taking the life of an innocent person. A Developing baby is a "qualified" member of the human race (Randy Alcorn - Abortion facts.com). These Old Testament verses should be taken into consideration. In Genesis 9:6 - *Whoso sheddeth man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made he man.* In the Old Testament, the Hebrew word "yeled" is used in the same way. In Exodus 21:22 it means an unborn child, *"If men struggle with each other and strike a woman with child so that she gives birth prematurely, yet there is no injury, he shall surely be fined as the woman's husband may demand of him, and he shall pay as the judges decide"* (NASB). **Scripture repeatedly condemns the killing of the innocent.** In Deuteronomy 27:25a - *Cursed is he who accepts a bribe to strike down an innocent person.* Proverbs 6:16-19 - There are six things which the LORD hates, yes, seven which are an abomination to Him: haughty eyes, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood...

God calls each of us to defend the innocent. Frank Favone in his article "The Bible's Teaching Against Abortion" says, *"An act of justice is an act of intervention for the helpless, an act of defense for those who are too weak to defend themselves. If God does justice for His people, He expects His people to do justice for one another."* "Be merciful as your heavenly Father is merciful" (Luke 6:36). *"Do unto others as you would have them do to you"* (Matthew 7:12). *"Love one another"* (John 15:17). Exodus 20:13 - *You shall not murder.*

Canada's Prime Minister is "dead wrong" in using the taxpayer's money by supporting and giving funds for abortion - because abortion is a failure to love, appreciate, and care for a human baby. *This contradiction must not be overlooked, lest we fail to see the cruelty, the degrading of humanity, and the violation of God's righteous decrees supported by those who hide behind the auspices of choice-advocacy* (Center for Reformed Theology and Apologetics). This constitutes the deliberate killing of an innocent human being. An unborn child is a human being, a separate individual from its mother.

What should a woman do if she realizes she did wrong? She does not need to spend the rest of her life with the burden of unforgiven guilt. God is just and willing to forgive sin if a person repents and if she will come to Him to follow His conditions.
