The reason there is confusion and division in "Religious Beliefs" is because the concept TRUTH, has been ignored and violated. There are many false teachings going around that confuse people. The keeping of God's commands here meant, was that of a sinner under a dispensation of mercy, of a believer having part in the covenant of grace." Confusion and conflict can easily stop when there is only ONE guide for us to follow.

When the Word of God is not respected and obeyed - that causes division and confusion! We wanted to be free from all of this conflict yet we do not go back to that TRUTH given to us. John 8:32 says; "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." We can be free from all confusion and conflicts. Our hearts are more satisfied and comfortable because we based our beliefs in the TRUTH long time offered to us by Jesus. Matthew Henry's Commentary says; "He encouraged them to attend his teaching, rely on his promises, and obey his commands, notwithstanding all temptations to evil. Thus doing, they would be his disciples truly; and by the teaching of his word and Spirit, they would learn where their hope and strength lay. Christ in the gospel offers us freedom, he has power to do this, and those whom Christ makes free are really so. But often we see persons disputing about liberty of every kind, while they are slaves to some sinful lust."

The only answer to our question is that – In truth, we are in Christ. In Christ, we have the hope of Salvation. Let us not be confused and be involved in any "squabbles" but let us just simply go back to His teaching and be true followers of Christ. Remember, Jesus prayed to the Father that all will be united (John 17:21). Truth can unite us.
